# DSM445 Picking Summary Print Management

---

## Overview

This program provides the facility to reprint and delete picking summary prints. The selection screen displays details information for each picking slip summary, such as: Run number, Mode, Date and time of print run, User responsible for generating the run, Number of picking summaries in the run, Number of prints generated, Total value and weight of goods within the picking summary.

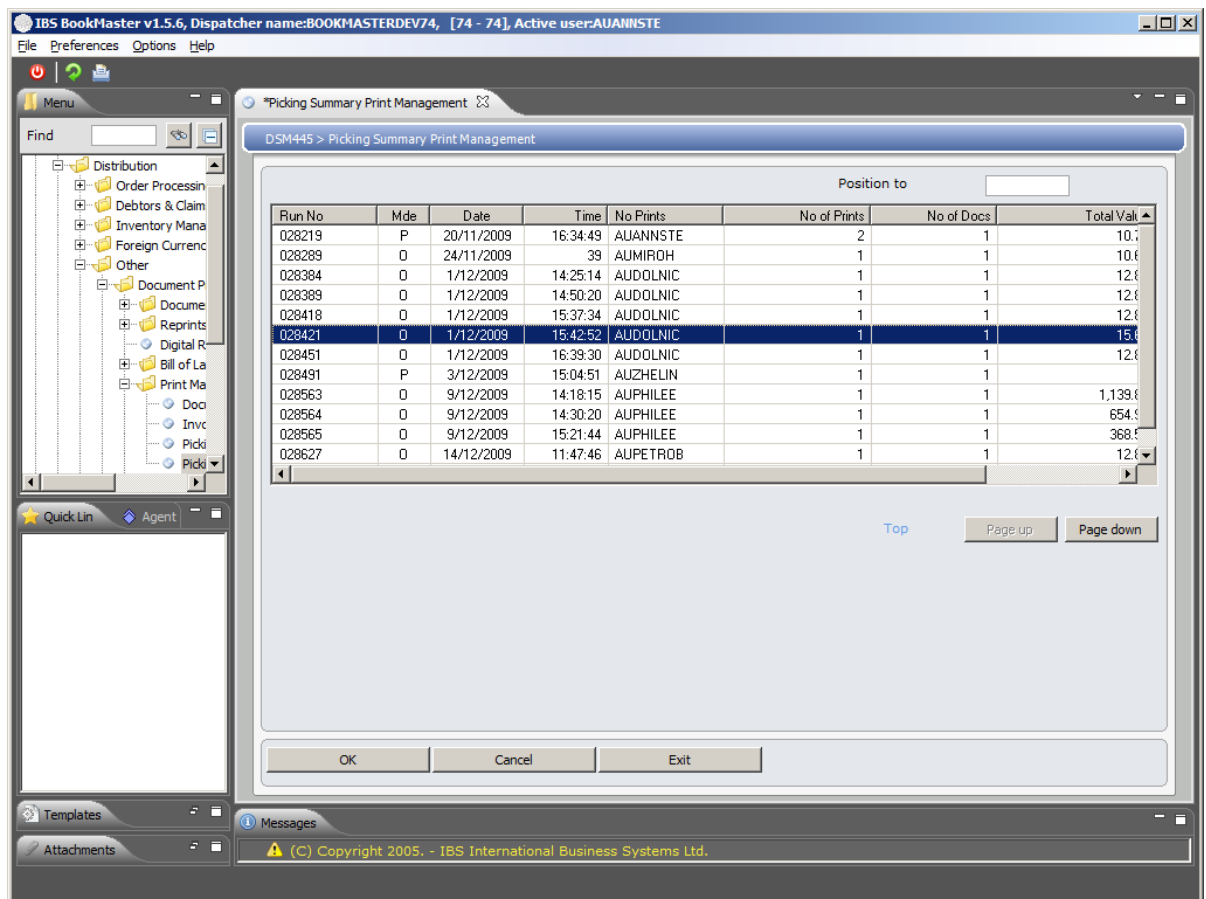

### Example 1: Reprint Original Picking Summary

This example describes how to reprint original picking summary.

1. Select option **Picking Summary Print Management** from Base Modules> Distribution> Other> Document Printing> Print Management menu.

**DSM445 Picking Summary Print Management** main panel is displayed.



## Options

### Delete

Access Picking Summary Print Management in delete mode to Delete a run/picking slip from print.

### Reprint

Access Picking Summary Print Management to Reprint Original run/picking slip.

## Relevant Fields

### Run number

The run number generated by the Release Order to Pick process displays. It is used for transactions with the status D (Currently in Warehouse), I (Document printed), or C (Completed processing).

### User

Definitions can be set up for individual users so that each time the user signs on, the system draws upon the calling parameter definition established for this user. The user code entered must be exactly the same as the User ID entered by this person on the sign on screen.

### No of prints

Enter the number of copies to print.

### Total value

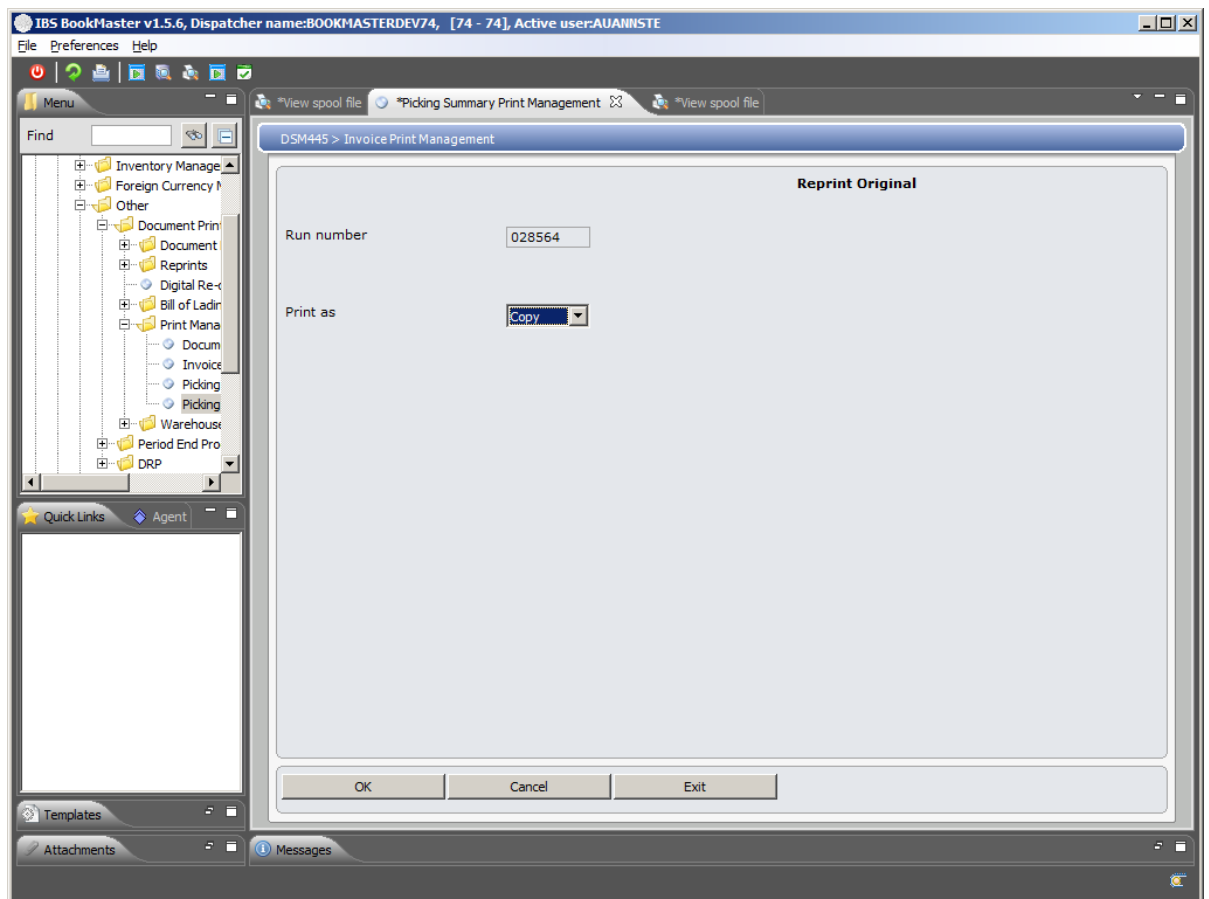
The total value of the order displays.

### Total weight

The total weight of the order in kilograms displays.

2. Select the run number and click **Reprint**.

**DSM445 Picking Summary Print Management** panel is displayed.

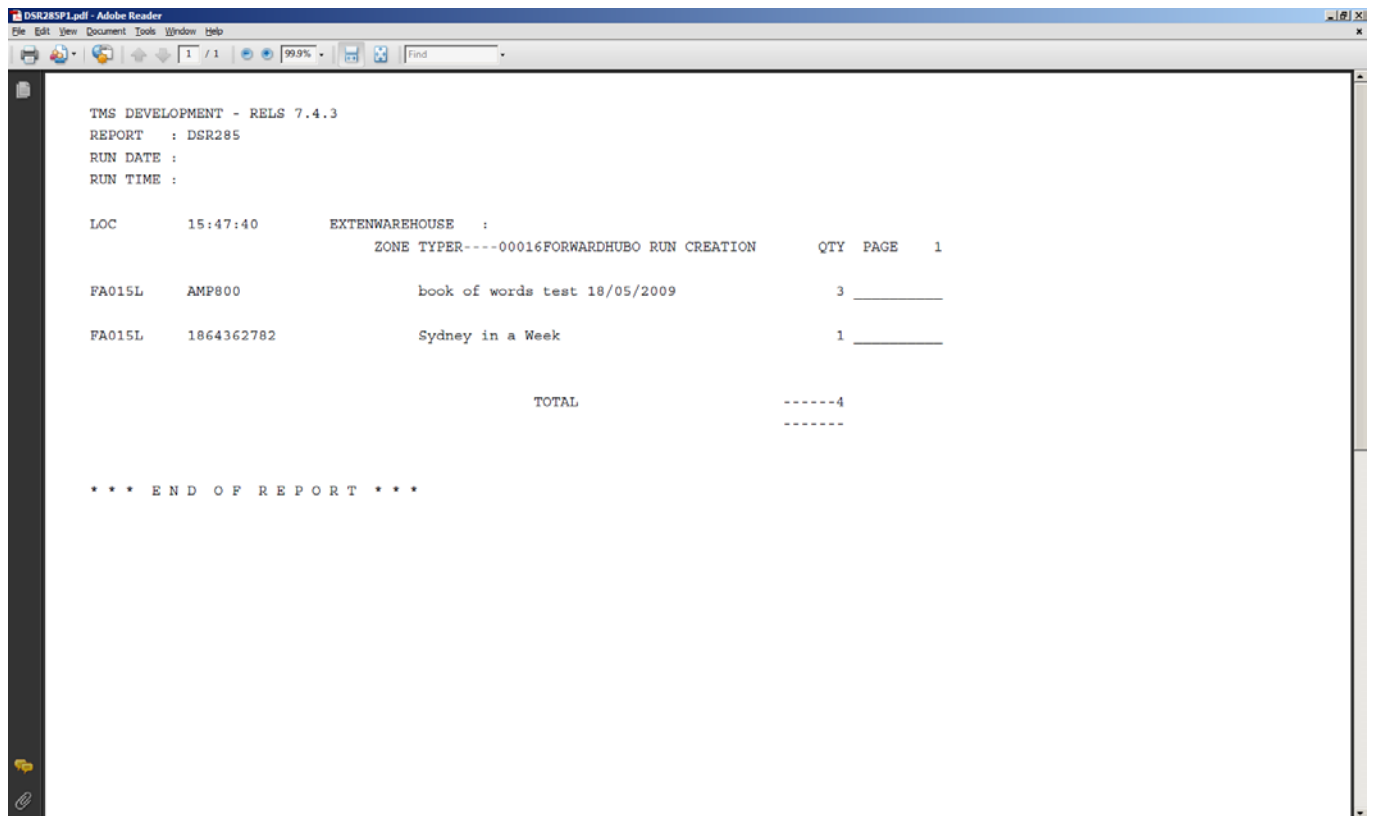


### Relevant Fields

**Print as**

Select whether to print the document as 1 = Original or as 2 = Copy.

Picking summary is generated.

## Example 2: Delete from queue option

This example describes how to delete from queue option.

1. Repeat step 1 as in [Example 1: Reprint Original Picking Summary](#)
2. Select a record and click **Delete**.

Record is deleted.
