# DSO161 Digital Re-download

---

## Overview

This program uses the process number or the picking slip number as an input and generates the digital item delivery instruction interface to Digital Product Distributor (DPD). The order can be automatically completed upon generation of delivery instructions interface or upon receipt of confirmation advice from DPD that the digital product has been downloaded. This is determined by the set-up in control file TMSDS/DGI-INV.

This program will generate the digital item delivery instruction interface to DPD when called from other programs as well. The order will be flagged as "Sent" on Direct Supply Item Tracking file only if the XML was sent successfully. If it was unsuccessful, the date/time stamp on the file will indicate as tried to send.

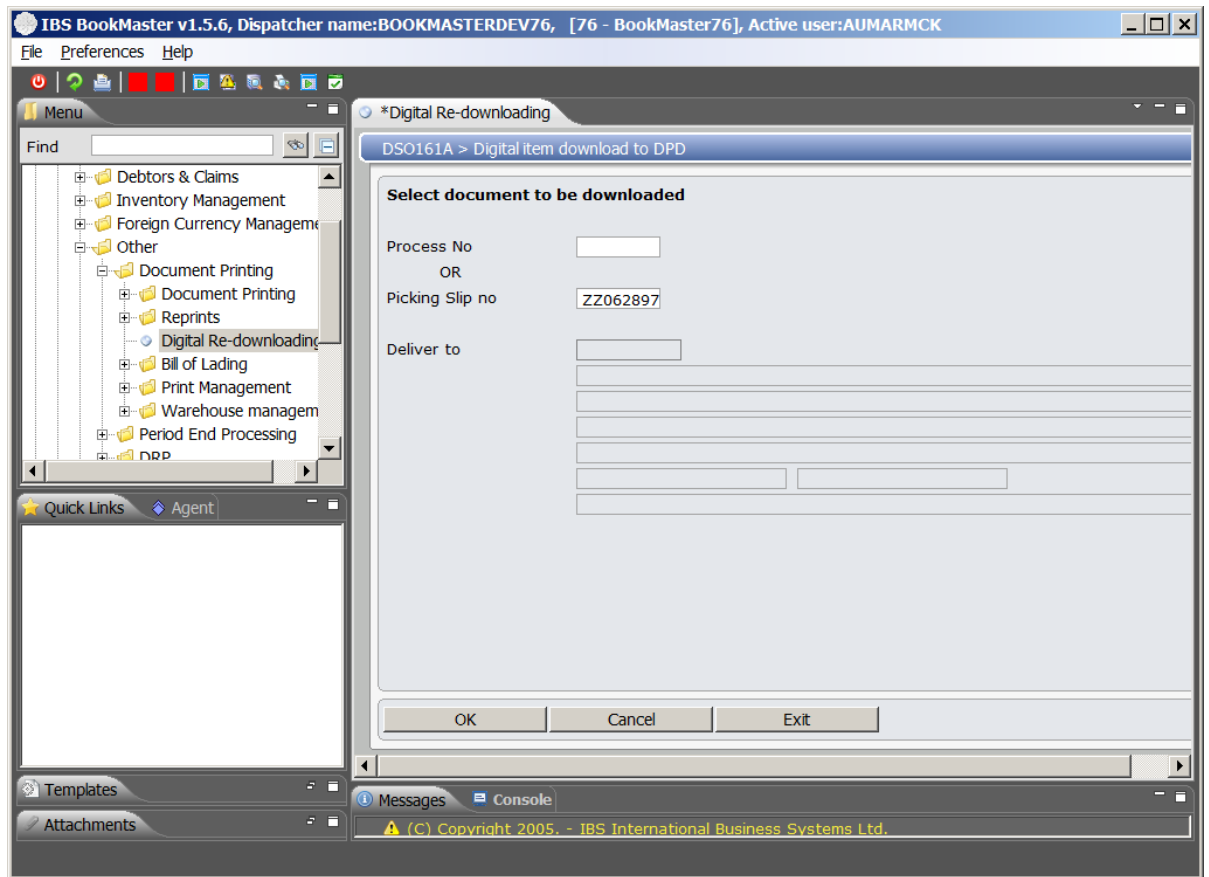

### Example 1: Re-download Digital Item Delivery Interface

This example describes how to re-download the DPD delivery instructions interface.

1. Select option **Digital Re-downloading** from Base Modules>Distribution>Other>Document Printing menu.

## Relevant Fields

### Process No

This is the unique system generated transaction process number for the digital product order that you wish to generate the delivery instructions interface for.

### Picking Slip no

Unique system generated picking slip number. Traditionally it is used for picking physical stock from different warehouse locations. For digital products the picking slip number is assigned even though there is no actual picking slip produced.

2. Enter the Process Number or the Picking Slip Number for the digital product order.
3. Click **OK** and confirm to generate the interface file.
