Overview Incoming standard Onix data from book production and editorial systems or from book suppliers / publishers are captured via the Item Masterfile Maintenance. It also includes standard user defined fields in the publishing industry, customer specific information are still stored as user defined fields in the extended database.

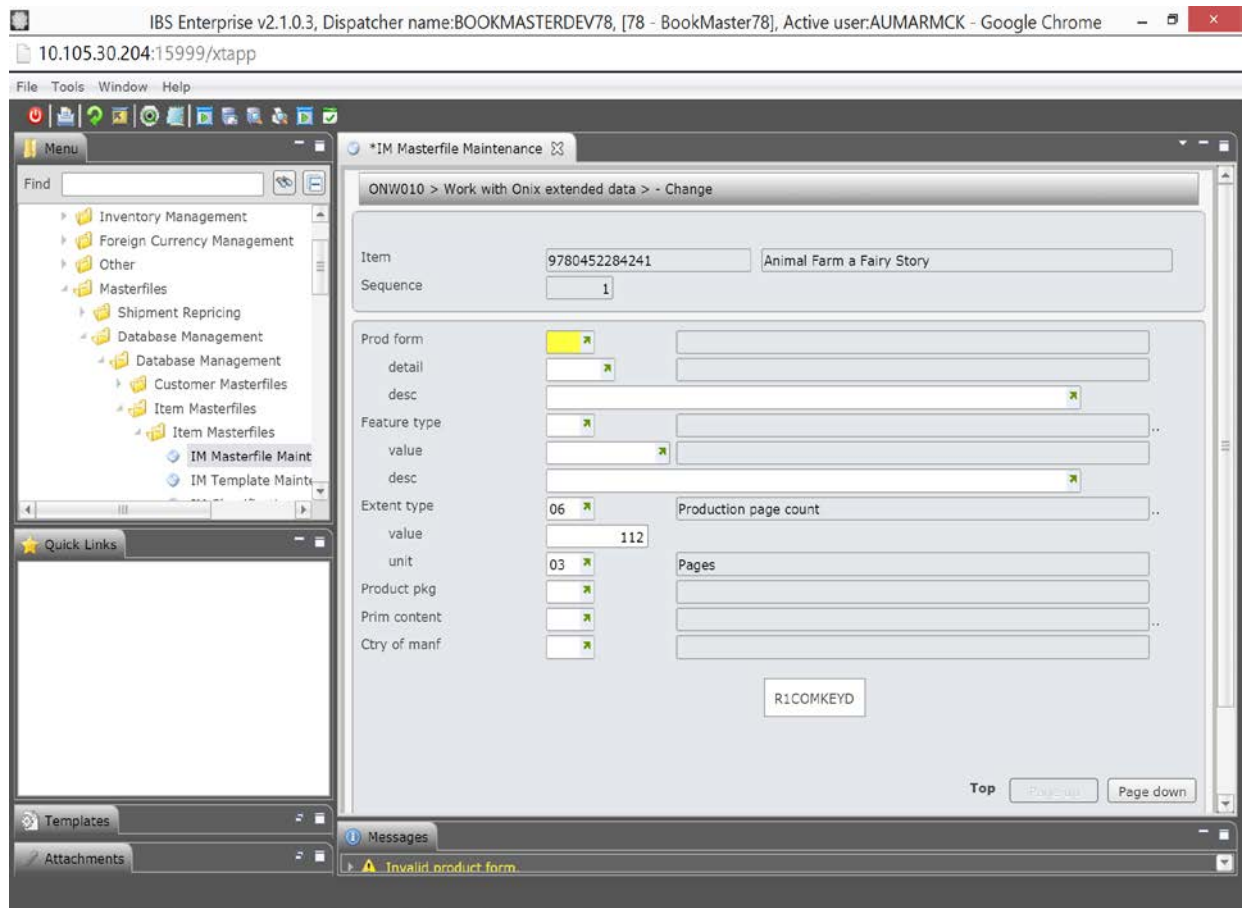

Example 1: Enter Onix Details

This example describes how to enter onix details for a title.

1. Select menu **IM Item Masterfile Maintenance** from Base Modules > Distribution > Masterfiles > Database Management > Database Management > Item Masterfiles > Item Masterfiles.
2. Select a title and the option **Onix Details**.
3. Click OK to continue.

Relevant fields

Prod form

Select a product form from the onix code list in control file ONIX/ON-LS150.

Feature type

Feature types are specified in control file ONIX/ON-LS079. Select a feature type from the list.

Extent type

Extent types are specified in control file ONIX/ON-LS023. Select an extent type from the list.

Product pkg

Select the type of packaging for the product from control file ONIX/ON-LS080.

Prim content

Primary content type specifies what type of content the product has e.g. music, game etc. Select from the list in control file ONIX/ON-LS081.

Ctry of manf

Country of manufacture is the ISO country code as specified in control file ONIX/ON-LS091. Select from the list.

Functions

Import

This will access DSI905 Item Alpha Search where you can search and select a title you can import the onix details from.
