# DSE501 Backorder Item Substitution

---

<i>Overview</i>	An outstanding title can be substituted in a single transaction. The title's outstanding orders are retrieved and substituted with an ISBN that is manually entered. The new ISBN also updates the Title Masterfile as the substitute for an old ISBN, to redirect any future orders.
<i>Purpose</i>	This panel allows you to: Substitute an Outstanding Item

---

## Explanation

B/O substitution checks substitution warehouse flag in **TMSDS/WH-DFTR** determines if substitution of B/O item is allowed for the drop ship warehouse. This will only be applicable if the original order is set-up to allow substitution in the first place when the order was initially created.

The valid values of this flag are:

- blank and '1' - allow substitution for this drop ship warehouse
- '2' – do not allow substitution for this drop ship warehouse even if the original order has been flagged to allow substitution.

This additional option can be used to disallow substitution on drop ship warehouse on orders that were originally set-up to allow substitution.

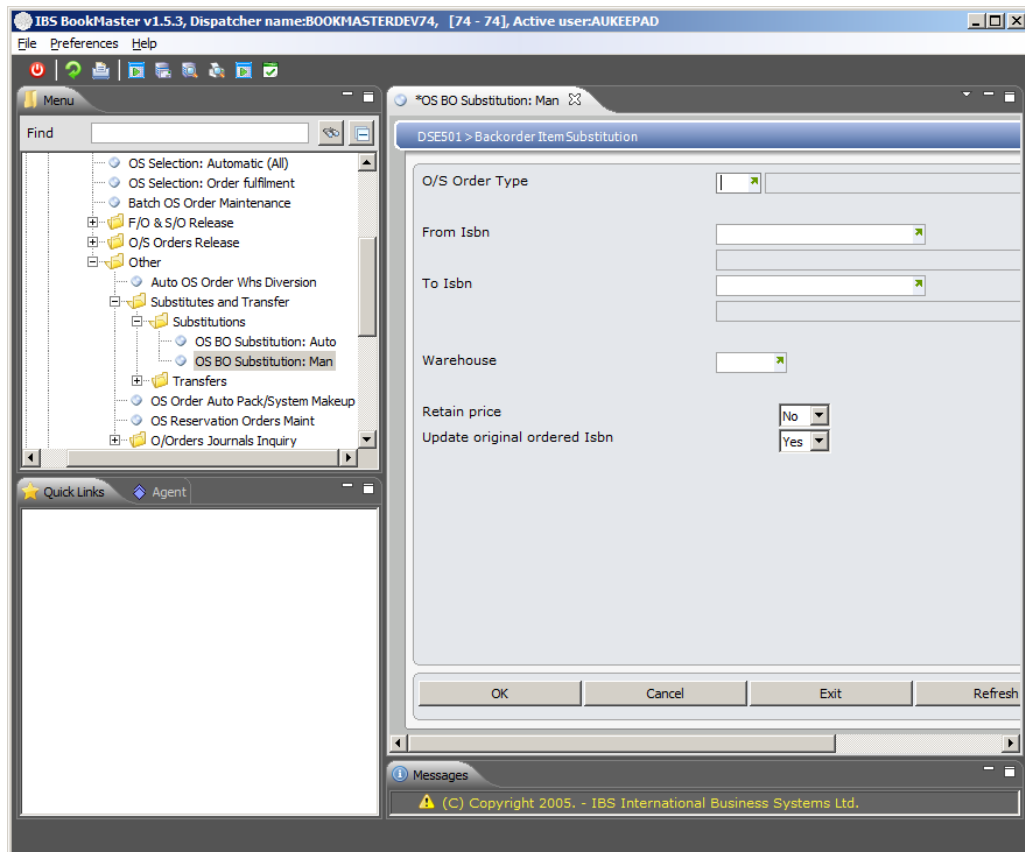

### Example 1: Substitution of an Outstanding Item

This example describes how to perform substitution of an outstanding item.

1. Select menu **OS BO Substitution: Man** from Base Modules>Distribution>Order Processing & Billing>Outstanding Orders>Other>Substitutes and Transfer>Substitutions menu.

## Relevant Fields

**From ISBN**

The ISBN to be replaced.

**To ISBN**

The ISBN to be substituted.

**Retain price**

If this is flagged as Yes the fixed price flag and the fixed discount flag are both set to Yes.

**Update original ordered ISBN**

This Yes/No field is used to indicate if the original ordered title is to be updated with the To ISBN code, on the outstanding order. This prevents invoices (resulting from O/S order releases) from printing the original ordered title as well as the substitute. Yes updates both the original title (From ISBN) field and the new title (To field). No updates only the new title (To field).

2. Key in required fields and click **OK** to execute substitution.
