# **DSO085 Back Order Release by Dollar**

Overview Outstanding titles can be gathered together by Minimum order value, Type of sale,

specific Branch, a Sales Rep, a Carrier Code, Run Number or by Minimum Invoice flag to produce a single order. This is run in a batch process flagging the title for release. The order will only be released if the minimum order value is met.

## **Explanation**

This process is subject to User Access Restrictions. Refer to User Access/Restrictions documentation for more information on this feature.

Orders are selected for release based on the entry of the:

- · Outstanding order type and, if required
- Minimum order value
- Type of sale
- Branch
- Sales Rep
- Carrier
- Run Number
- Minimum Invoice Flag Y/N

On completion of the selections, the release is generated via the Outstanding Order Release option, which requires the entry of the Outstanding Order Type code. A report prints, showing all the release details.

The backorder release is generated via the Outstanding Orders Release option. A report prints, showing all release details.

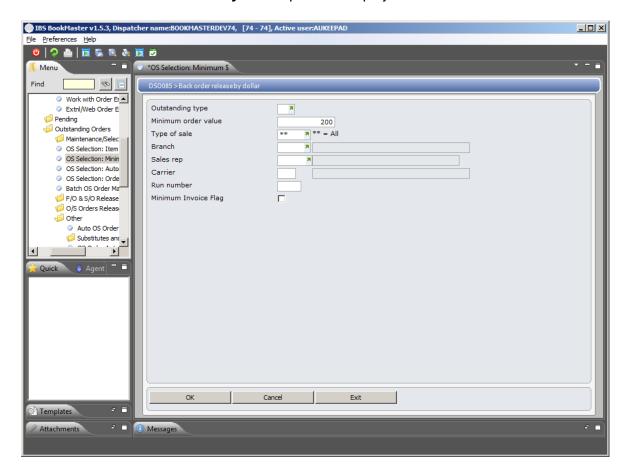
Example 1: Back Order Release by Dollar

Minimum invoice In Order Processing the Minimum Charge flag from the

### charge flag

Customer Masterfile defaults.

Yes means a minimum charge applies. The order or invoice value is checked against a predefined limit. If the limit is exceeded, the minimum charge does not apply. However, if the order value is below this limit, an additional charge is printed on the invoice to make up the total of the invoice to that minimum amount. A special ISBN is used and the difference between the total of the invoice and the minimum amount is the line item value. No means a minimum charge does not apply as the minimum value of the order is not checked.

In Backorder Release by Dollar the minimum charge flag can be overridden.

#### 2. Key in required fields and click **OK**.

The orders are released and a report generated giving details of the released orders. Select to run in a batch print at the end of day or allocate the report to your spool file.
