

Example 1: Addition of a new campaign list

This example describes how to add a new campaign list.


 Select option Work with DM Campaigns from Other Modules>Direct Mail>Maintenance menu.

DMW010 Work with Campaigns main panel is displayed.




2. Select an existing campaign and click Lists.

DMM020 Work with Campaign Lists panel is displayed.



3. Click Add.

DMM025 Campaign list Maintenance panel is displayed in **Add** mode to add a new campaign list.



Relevant fields

Campaign A user defined, alphanumeric code, which uniquely identifies

a direct mail campaign

List A Campaign List ID or number is required and entered in

Campaign Maintenance. Entry of the List may be a duplicate of another List for a different campaign. The Campaign List

key code is unique for each campaign.

Description A description of a Campaign List is optional in Campaign

The category in which the list falls

Maintenance.

When copying a Campaign List, a new description for the campaign list being created can be entered or if left blank, the

description defaults from the existing campaign list.

Campaign list type

no.

Campaign key code

A Campaign key code or ID is required to identify the List within the Campaign. This is entered in Campaign Maintenance. Each Campaign List must have a Campaign Key Code (ID) so it can be identified within the order entry

system as a Direct Mail campaign. Duplicates are not

allowed.

Mailing qty planned

The quantity of brochures to be printed or mail outs to be sent

to prospective customers for this Campaign List.

Mailing quantity The actual quantity of brochures printed or mail outs sent to

actual prospective customers for this Campaign List.

Mailing date The Date entered on the Campaign for when brochures and

letters are to be sent out. This field defaults and can be

overridden. Click on the calendar to select a date.

Type of sale A Type of Sale code the List is targeting. This field defaults

to Direct Mail and can be overridden. **Prompt** and select a valid Type of Sale code for Direct Mail Sales Analysis in

Distribution.

Test code The default is No and may be overridden to Yes. This

Yes/No flag determines whether this campaign is a test and is

flagged within TMSDM/CPGN-EXP.

It allows a test campaign to be run for a subject. This is used

to see what customer types are selected and how many

customers are selected.

Total list expense The expense associated with the direct mail campaign list

which is being created or added.

When entering the cost, TMSDM/CPGN-EXP must be set to

Y.

4. Key in the required fields and click OK.

DMM020 Campaign Item Maintenance and DME081 Mailing List Selection panels are displayed one after the other. Please refer to corresponding documents for further details.

After the values are keyed in, a campaign list gets added.

Example 2: Maintenance of an existing campaign list details

This example describes how to maintain an existing campaign list details.

- 1. Repeat steps 1 and 2 as in Example 1: Addition of a new campaign list
- 2. Select an existing campaign list and click on Change.

DMM025 Campaign list Maintenance panel is displayed in **Change** mode to change existing campaign list details.

3. Make required changes and click Delete (or press F15).

This changes existing campaign list details.

Example 3: Deletion of campaign list

This example describes how to delete campaign list.

- Repeat steps 1 and 2 as in Example 1: Addition of a new campaign list
- 2. Select an existing campaign and click on Profile.

DMM025 Confirm Deletion of Campaign List panel is displayed.

3. Click OK to confirm deletion.

This deletes existing campaign list.
