
DSO570 Catalogue Re-sequence

Overview

The Catalogue Re-sequence program changes the sequence of an automatic catalogue and renumbers a manual one. If no entry is made then it rebuilds the catalogue. This program submits a job (via Submitter) to update the sequence key for all elements in the selected range of Catalogues or items.



Example 1: Catalogue Re-sequence

This example describes how to select catalogues for re-sequence.

1. Select option **E-Commerce Re-sequence Catalogue** from Other Modules> E-Commerce> Maintenance menu.

Relevant Fields

Catalogue type

This field identifies if the catalogue is either a Folder or a List type. If adding a main catalogue the type must be a Folder. In Catalogue Re-sequencing, select whether it is a Folder or List being re-sequenced.

Catalogue ID

Entry of the catalogue ID to be re-sequenced is optional. A single catalogue ID or a range of catalogue IDs can be entered.

Sequence method

The sequence for a catalogue can be Automatic or Manual. In Create Catalogue Lists from MP entry of the sequence method is an optional override. In Catalogue Re-sequencing selecting a Sequence Method to be re-sequenced is also optional.

Sequence definition

Entry of the sequence definition is an optional override. If Automatic is selected in the previous field (Sequence Method) then this field becomes mandatory. In Catalogue Re-sequencing an entry in this field is also dependent on a selection in the Sequence Method field. Sequence definitions are established in **TMSDS/CAT-SEQA** if a folder is used and **TMSDS/CAT-SEQC** if a list is used.

2. Click **OK** to confirm and the catalogue will get re-sequenced.
